Configure or change the Wi-Fi network settings on a LG webOS screen

- 1. Turn off the LG webOS screen completely, turn it on again and wait until it is fully booted.
- 2. Press the "Settings" button on the remote control (gear icon).
- 3. Use the arrow keys on the remote control to navigate to General
- 4. Press the \rightarrow arrowkey to enter the General menu, navigate to **Network** and press "**OK**".



5. Select Wi-Fi connection and press "OK" to confirm.

6. Select an available Wi-Fi network and press "OK".



- 7. Enter the password and select **Connect** to confirm. An IP address will now be issued from the Wi-Fi network and a message will appear that an internet connection is available.
- 8. Finally, press the "**back**" \bigcirc button on the remote control multiple times to close the Settings menu of the screen.
- 9. The screen will then start downloading all relevant media from the Gauddi CMS and start playing.
- 10. Press the blue button on the remote control to invoke the status screen for more information. Press the blue button multiple times to exit this status screen.
